## INTERNATIONAL STUDENT FINANCIAL INFORMATION

**Application Fee** (for new students) – A one-time, non-refundable fee of \$100 covers the application process, and carrier services for acceptance letters and documents sent to the student.

**Enrollment/Reenrollment Fee** - This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable - \$300

**SEVIS I-901 Fee** – International students who plan to study at Horizon Christian School are considered as an F-1 status. All F-1 status students are mandated to pay the I-90 fee to the government (U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement) toward the support of the Student Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP). This must be done before a visa appointment with the American Consulate. Please visit this web site for more information and to pay this fee.

**International Tuition** – This fee includes grade level activity fees, one sports fee, and yearbooks for either middle or high school students. TOEFL/IELTS testing one time each year for all students.

**Medical Insurance** – All students are required to have medical insurance.

**Host Family Placement Fee**– This \$100 fee covers the host family application process and background checks for Horizon Christian families. This fee is waived if a student has made arrangements with their own host family. If a student chooses to move to another host family, an additional \$100 fee will be charged.

**Host Family/Student Care (Student Room Stay Concierge)** - Horizon Christian School is partnering with Student Room Stay Concierge to bring the best homestay and student care possible. All new independent students that need a host family will be placed in Student Room Stay Concierge's homestay program. With this program parents will have monthly reports available regarding the student, host family, and school events. **Host Family Stipend** - This fee is paid to the school for a 10-month period. The school will issue the money appropriately to the host family.

**New Student Orientation Fee** - All new high school students are required to attend this orientation. The 2021-2022 Fall orientation is from August 18-27, 2021. The first day of classes is August 30, 2021.

**ESL Support** - For students who fall below English proficiency requirements, English support and ESL Bible & Culture is offered for the first year. Each student is evaluated on an individual basis during the two-week orientation to determine if ESL support is needed.

## **OTHER FEES**

---

**TOEFL/IELTS Test** - One TOEFL/IELTS test per year is included in the registration fee. Students will need to pay an additional fee if they take more than one test per year.

**Incidental Fees** - Incidental fees are fees charged to students for circumstances of damaged or lost books/school materials or damage to the school property.

**Promotion and Graduation Fees**- 8th grade promotion fee is \$50. 12th grade graduation fee is \$150.

**Sports Fee** - One sports fee is included in tuition. Students participating in more than one sport will need to pay \$125 for middle school and \$200 for high school, for each additional sport. This fee will be paid to the athletic department.

**Postage/Handling Fee** - For students requesting a yearbook mailed to their home country, there will be a required postage fee that needs to be paid to the school. This fee will depend on the U.S. Postal service international shipping rates for that country.

**Lunch Fee** - There is no hot lunch program offered at Horizon Christian School. At the high school a student store is available to purchase some convenient food.

## **MAKING PAYMENTS**

---

Two choices are available for tuition and fee payments:

1. Full payment due by August 1<sup>st</sup>
2. Semester payments:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> payment due by August 1<sup>st</sup>
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> payment due by January 1<sup>st</sup>

Students may not participate in class if tuitions and fees are not paid. Once a student begins class, tuition for that semester is not refundable.
