Loyalty Discount Program

Horizon offers a Loyalty Discount towards a high school student's tuition if they maintain continuous enrollment at Horizon for at least two consecutive years prior to entering the 9th grade. For every two consecutive years your student remains with Horizon, you will earn \$500 off your student's tuition beginning as a freshman.

The Loyalty Discount only applies to families who are not already receiving other discounts (except multistudent and single payment discounts). The program will stop accruing discounts once your student(s) enters high school. However, the Loyalty Discount will continue each year your student remains in the high school. This discount will be applied automatically to qualifying students.

Financial AidVariable Tuition Program

Our Variable Tuition program is a needs-based tuition assistance program that adjusts tuition for qualifying families based on financial need. The tuition discount a family may be awarded is determined by FACTS Financial Aid, a third-party financial assessment company.
