



HORIZON CHRISTIAN HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS AND GRADE SCALE

Horizon Christian High School has been accredited through Cognia since 2006. The school is organized into two 18-week semesters with permanent grades issued at the completion of each semester. Students take 8 classes per semester. Using a block schedule, they take four 80-minute classes each day with a 25-minute C.O.R.E class at the end of the day. C.O.R.E. is a time for students to work on the fundamental skills of being a successful student with a focus on time management, note and test taking strategies, and much more. Students need 28 credits to graduate from Horizon Christian.
