Program Overview

Our International Student Program (ISP) facilitates the English immersion process through high-quality formal education. Our objective is to have all international students enrolled in mainstream courses by their second year. We are a college preparatory school that focuses on helping our students succeed academically and prepare for university.

Recognizing that international students may be unfamiliar with American culture, we partner with each student individually to ensure their success in the program through:

- A week-long orientation
- Bi-monthly reviews of each student's progress
- 30-minute monthly student assessments
- University preparation guidance
- Daily access to ISP Director and counselor
